- II. Commissioned Officers of all grades are also responsible for the adherence of their commands to them.
- III. Major Frederick Sineath, Acting Inspector General of the Army is charged with ensuring all members of the Army are in compliance while in the field at the event.

1. Flags
2. Company size: the current order is 40 men minimum with the Park's approval.
3. Tentage and Camps
