The following procedures for forage will be adhered to for the Perryville campaign.

- I. The Park will be providing 2.5 bales of forage per animal for the event.
- II. Forage will be distributed at a drop point in between the Calvary and Artillery in the Military camp.
- III. In order for a Public mount to receive their allotted forage, Form No. 32 must be submitted to Army Quartermaster Department by the unit commander. The form will be submitted one time and will enumerate the total animals for the command.
- IV. Public horses are those in the service of the cavalry, artillery, and teamsters. Officer's and any other mounts are Private horses.
- V. Form No. 32, Forage Requisition for Public Horses, will be provided to the Cavalry and Artillery Commanders and to the Quartermaster in charge of Teamsters.
- VI. All Men who desire to receive issue for Private horses must first obtain Form No. 33, Forage Requisition for Private Horses, from Army headquarters.
- VII. No one will appropriate forage without the proper form signed by the Army Quartermaster.
- VIII. These procedures have been established to prevent the misuse of forage as human bedding. While an ample supply, once gone there will not be a resupply.
