General Order No.} 11

The purpose of the Military Camp is to endeavor to recreate the appearance of one of the bivouacs of Army of the Mississippi during the Perryville campaign. Historic record indicates that very, very few Civilians were embedded with the troops.

The mixed camp has been set aside to ameliorate the experience of civilians and provide an optimal venue for their impressions. Those civilians who have a desire to visit the military camp must receive prior permission from Army Headquarters.

For that reason the following is promulgated:

- I. Civilian participants are barred from camping in the Military Camp without prior approval from the General Commanding.
- II. Application for exemption may be made by applying to the AAG prior to the event.
- III. Ample accommodation has been made by the Park for Civilians in the Mixed Camp, which is conveniently located with respect to the Military Camp.
- IV. Civilians who desire to enter the Military Camp will request permission from Army Headquarters.
