General Order No.} 6, series 1862

- I. The following are *the only Colors authorized* to be displayed within the Park, *either on or off the field*, for the duration of the event:
 - a. Infantry Regiments: Polk on Saturday, Hardee on Sunday.
 - b. Artillery: Washington Artillery on Sunday
 - c. Cavalry: The Bonnie Blue on Saturday.
 - d. Brigade Commanders: a diminutive version of the 1st National, either on or off the field.
 - e. Army Commander: a 1st National either on or off the field.
- II. Polk, Hardee, and the Washington Artillery Colors will be supplied by the Park. They will be issued:
 - a. Saturday morning at the conclusion of the specified drill period.
 - b. Sunday morning prior to marching to that day's scenario.
- III. Colors supplied by the Park will be returned to Army Headquarters shortly after each day's scenario.
- IV. Regimental Commanders are held individually responsible for the care and return of the Park's colors to Army Headquarters.

The limitation on the use of colors will help to ensure that we the participants can continue to portray the Southern Soldier with both accuracy and dignity upon State owned property.
