Special Order No.} 4, series 1862

On the 16th instant Mr. Frazer requested special permission to enter the Park on Wednesday 5 October for the purpose of resting battery horses and preparing camp for the later arrival of other elements of his command. In response:

- I. Mr. Frazer is granted permission to enter the Park on the 5th of October.
- II. Mr. Frazer is tasked with coordinating arrival time and number of mounts with Maj. Aycock.
- III. Maj. Aycock is responsible for forwarding the information provided by Mr. Frazer in No. II above to: Lt. J. Sturckler - AAG of the Army, and Capt. J. Sunderland - AQM of the Army.
- IV. Gen'l Watters and advance elements of Army Staff will arrive in the area on Tuesday 4 October and be on-site Wednesday morning to ensure that Mr. Frazer locates in the designated area.
- V. The 'General Camp Map' will be issued shortly for reference.
